Bourne-Vanneck Shield

Aggregate Team Competition.
Teams of three men.
Stroke play all three scores to count.
Maximum playing handicap - 18

Top Rock Salver (pairs)

A weekday better ball match play competition. A Club team will be comprised of one pair playing four ball better ball match play at a single venue. The area winners will be drawn into national semi-finals, which shall be played on neutral courses. The winners of each semi-final shall meet in the national final which will be part of the NAPGC Finals weekend

Siemens Bowl 2020 (handicap 16+)

A Club Team will comprise of eight players, four players must have playing handicaps of 19+. All pairs to play 18 holes Better Ball Stableford. Two pairs will play at home and two pairs will play away and the team score is the aggregate of the home and away points. All matches will be played from the appropriate medal tees.
Players are entitled to ninety percent (90%) of their playing handicap.
This is a knock-out competition.

Clapham Common Platinum Shield

Six pairs per team playing stableford greensomes, three pairs play at home and three pairs play away. The stroke allowance is as defined and published in the current CONGU Handbook – lower handicap x 0.6 plus higher handicap x 0.4.

The winners of each semi-final shall meet in the national final which will be played as part of the NAPGC Finals weekend.
