THE BENEFITS OF HIGH ELMS GOLF CLUB MEMBERSHIP

For many competitions or to play on most courses at home and abroad you will need a recognised handicap. High Elms Golf Club is authorised to issue and administer handicaps for its members. It is responsible for organising competitions and all playing members must be affiliated to England Golf and Kent Golf (a new organisation arising from the unification of the Kent Golf Union and the Kent County Ladies Golf Association).

The Club has three active Sections:

- The Ladies Section which arranges competitions on week-ends, mid-week and Bank Holidays.
- The Men's Section which arranges competitions on week-ends and Bank Holidays.
- The Seniors Section which arranges competitions for male members over 60 who wish to play on weekdays.

All members may enter all competitions throughout the year.

All members are encouraged to participate in the extensive calendar of internal and external events. Committee members look forward to meeting new members and introducing them to other Club members.

Various tee times are reserved for the use of Club members.

The Membership Package

When you join you will receive a bag tag (so that we can recognise our members), a copy of the Club's Constitution and Code of Conduct, a competition diary (which also explains how each internal competition is run as well as containing relevant contact details), a data protection statement and a copy of the CONGU handicapping guidelines. All members will be able to apply online for a KG Card which is available as part of their affiliation fee and entitles holders to discounts at a number of other courses.

Handicaps

If you do not hold a competition handicap you will be required to submit 3 cards marked by a Club member. The Club encourages all members to obtain and maintain their handicaps through regular entry to Club competitions. **All members seeking handicap must have paid their membership and affiliation fees (see over).**
